



#### **ASTM Exo CoE Vision**




The CoE program vision is for people of all ages to be free to pursue a high-quality life and participate fully in work and society thanks to safe and reliable exo technologies.

> ASTM Exo Technology Center of Excellence

#### Anticipated Funding Amount:

➤ Up to \$250K annually for five years, provided from in-kind contributions combined with funds, with the possibility of exceeding \$250K from provided in-kind contributions

#### Award Period:

Annually by calendar year, up to five years with annual reviews, with a three-year base period and a two-year option period

- Who can apply to this RFP?




